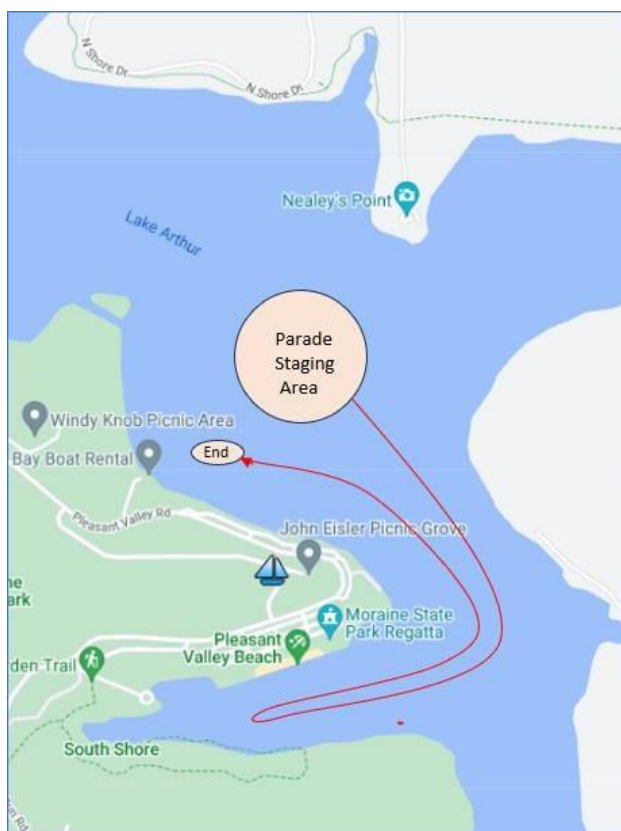




Ahoy Moraine State Park Boaters!

The Moraine State Park Regatta will again have a boat parade this year. These are the details:

- All boats *with motors* (sailboats, pontoon boats, fishing boats, etc.) may participate. Due to safety concerns, canoes, kayaks, paddleboards and similar watercraft cannot participate.
- All boats must meet legal safety requirements (e.g.: Life Jackets, etc.)
- Participants are highly encouraged to decorate their boat.
- The parade will be led by USCC Auxiliary. Observing safety is their first priority.
- Boats will **gather between Nealey's Point and Crescent Bay between 5:40 and 6 PM Saturday** and line up behind the USCC Aux. leader.
- At 6 PM the parade will proceed slowly, in line, under power (not sail) to the Pleasant Valley Inlet and parade by the beach, then return to Crescent Bay and disband. See diagram:



- Boats with radios should monitor VHF channel 14 for parade advisories.
- The parade route will be guided through deep water as some sailboat keels need the depth.
- The slow-moving parade will not last longer than 1 hour. Other Regatta water activities in the area are scheduled to conclude by 6PM but parade boaters must be vigilant to avoid other watercraft in the area.
- Keep up with the boat ahead of you to prevent distracting parade gaps and stragglers.

After the parade, consider anchoring or rafting up to view the evening fireworks.
